BBQ

Edo/Ella/Wyatt to assist in setting up BBQ

- BBQ complete, was successful
- Venue had a fire ban so we couldn't use Vera's burgers for BBQ. Club used Panago and Dominos instead
- Domino's online pizza calculator was used. Club could have underestimated their guess by 10% and been okay
- Pizza was much cheaper, very easy to set up, and allowed for a variety of options, including vegetarian
- Some people asked about dancing at the bbq, but the board did not rent a floor this year. To be considered next year
- Some concern about neighbour's garbage the club had the entire area but allowed others to use some picnic benches because we didn't have a need for them. Other people left a lot of garbage, but no complaints were heard from parks board.

- a. Automation

- b. Extra Dances

- c. BAMEO Workshop Weekend
 - 32 registered, 18 leads, 14 follows at time of meeting
 - Private lesson studios narrowed down to two places
 - Dance cost is about \$1,700 plus instructor-related charges

 - BAMEO unsure if they can stay at acquaintances, may need a hotel near the venue
 - We have around 16 hours of material, and we can pick what to focus our 8 hours on – survey?
 - If a board member volunteers, they can have the lower tier price
