#### 8. Event Review

- a. Attendance:
  - i. 26 people attended the introduction class
  - ii. 35 people attended the intermediate class
  - iii. 97 people attended the dance
- b. Financials:



- i. revenue: \$1,670
- ii. expenses: \$860
- iii. profit: \$810
- c. Overall Feedback:
  - i. The event was well attended, there was only positive feedback
  - ii. The costume party went over well, and the costume contest was a fun touch
  - iii. Approximately a third of the dance attendees stayed until the end of the event
  - iv. Registration with the iPad went well
  - v. Chris is a good greeter and would like to continue with that role rather than being at the front desk
  - vi. The front desk was closed at around 21:40 because it seemed that nobody else was showing up and people don't typically show up past 21:30
  - vii. Henry, the introduction instructor called in sick and Dalynne was kind enough to fill in on short notice
- 9. Future dances
  - a. Dates for Pending dances:
    - i. Confirmed: Nov 18, Dec 9, Jan 20
    - ii. Pending: Feb 3, Mar 16
      - February and March dates will be booked on a month-to-month basis
  - b. Backup Instructor for Dec?
    - i. No backup instructor is needed, if Pam can't make it due to ferry issues, we will replace the lesson with a dance. The December DJ knows about this contingency
  - c. DJ's for 2024:
    - i. In 2024, consider splitting up the night into two sections and pair a new DJ with an experienced DJ to play for the night
  - d. Live Music Event
    - i. A few folks in the community are talented musicians and have a band together and would be willing to play for approx. an hour at one of our regular dances
    - ii. This event wouldn't have a lesson, instead, the band would play
    - iii. The band would bring most of their own equipment: instruments, amps, etc. but may need assistance with sound hookups
    - iv. A few members of the board will attend a practice session to get a feel for the music they want to play at the event
    - v. Dates for 2023 are filled up, but this would be great in 2024
  - e. By donation Intro Class Workshop
    - i. The September workshop was not advertised as intermediate only so a few new dancers showed up and paid for the classes



- ii. Michael/Amy and Tessa/Miles are interested in teaching a beginner set of lessons
- iii. Discussion:
  - Options: 1) host two intro workshop days where Michael/Amy teach at one and Tessa/Miles teach at the other. 2) Michael/Amy and Tessa/Miles alternate teaching in a single event.
  - The date will be in 2024
  - Marketing for this event: re-engage with CBC to promote on the radio, and promote on a morning news show
  - 2-2.5 hours of classes book 3-3.5 hours to include time for breaks, questions, and practice time
  - Hosting the intermediate class: TBD
  - We would host these intro classes by-donation
- f. Silent Disco Event
  - i. Host 3 DJs who play their own music
